

Actions Taken

Program Level

- Implementation of the new Plan of Study from Fall 2019 with a Business minor.
- Improvement of online course delivery synchronously and asynchronously through Canvas and Kaltura Media Space
- Back to in-person course delivery from Fall 2022 except CMGT 32000. CMGT 32000 is tentatively offered only online due to the instructor's availability limitation.

Course Level

The following actions are examples that the instructor's actions reflecting student course evaluations. In addition, many other courses have been updated to improve the quality of the course materials and student learning experience.

- CMGT 15000 (Fall 2022): course material updated for the survey lab to improve the learning experience and increase field lab activities to enhance the knowledge on the survey labs including levels and turning angels using a total station.
- CMGT 11000 (Fall 2020): the selected textbook contains more subjects than taught during the semester. The instructor updated and rearranged the topical schedules to cover four more subjects/chapters in construction management content as shown in the updated course topical outlines in the orange box.
